



2020 SuperCamp Scholarship Application GENERAL INFORMATION

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

All application forms must be received by end of day on Thursday, April 30, 2020, to be considered. Please include the following with your fully completed application forms.

- Recent student photo
- Letter of reference from a teacher, counselor, or coach
- Copy of latest IRS tax return (first page only) or other proof of income
- Additional sheets for Parts 2 and 3, if needed
- Signed Commitment Agreement (Part 4)

Reminder: include tuition contribution payment information on application if applicable. Check or credit card information will be processed only if scholarship is awarded and accepted.

When completing application, please make sure the student, not the parent, fills out Part 3 (Student Review) and Part 4 (Commitment Agreement).

IMPORTANT DATES

- Applications due: April 30, 2020
- Award notifications: June 1, 2020
- Tuition contribution due for winning applicants: June 15, 2020

GENERAL

- Travel costs to and from SuperCamp are not included. Make sure you can afford the transportation costs before applying for and accepting a scholarship.
- Previous winners can apply but priority is given to applicants who have never attended SuperCamp.
- Your letter of reference can be from a coach, a counselor, or a teacher. We are looking for them to speak specifically about their experience with you. They do not have to know anything about SuperCamp but we recommend that you refer them to SuperCamp.com to learn about the program.
- We award full and partial scholarships.
- The number of full and partial SuperCamp scholarships awarded each year varies and depends on the amount of funds donated to LFI for SuperCamp scholarships and the amount that families contribute toward tuition.
- Awards are based on the academic and personal needs of the student and the financial need of the student's family.

HOT TIPS (suggested but not required)

- Send all application materials together—and mail early.
- Write a cover letter from the heart and tell us your story.
- Be creative to make your application stand out. For example, include photos, drawings, etc.—anything that shows more about who you are.
- Be flexible with campus and date choices.
- Show your enthusiasm for attending SuperCamp by completing multiple items on the Commitment Agreement.
